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READ THE TEXT AND DO THE EXERCISES

HEDY LAMARR

Hedy Lamarr was born in 1914 and died in 2000. She was an Austrian-born American film actress and inventor. Her father belonged to a Jewish family and was a successful bank director. Her mother was a pianist who came from an upper-class Jewish family.

After a brief early film career in Czechoslovakia, including the controversial movie Ecstasy (1933) in which she swam and ran nude, she left her extremely controlling husband, a fairly rich Austrian ammunition manufacturer, and secretly moved to Paris. There, she met one the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer studio owners, Louis B. Mayer, who offered her a movie contract. Mayer persuaded her to change her name to Hedy Lamarr. He brought her to Hollywood in 1938 and began promoting her as the "world's most beautiful woman". She became a film star from the late 1930s to the 1950s.

Lamarr was married and divorced six times and she had three children. She went with her first husband to business meetings with scientists and other professionals involved in military technology. Thanks to that she discovered her talent in applied science and she worked in her spare time on various inventions.

At the beginning of World War II, Lamarr and her friend the composer and pianist George Antheil developed a radio guidance system for torpedoes, which used spread spectrum technology. Although the US Navy did not adopt the technology until the 1960s, the principles of their invention helped in the development of GPS, Bluetooth, and Wi-Fi.
